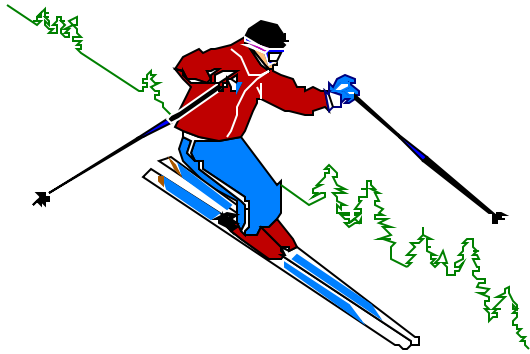

SKIING

A new ski season will soon be here - hope your skis are sharp and ready to go! The preliminary ski schedule is out on page 4. In addition to our scheduled lodge trips, members can take advantage of our western trip, extended eastern trip, and the EPSC Winter Carnival.

Winter Carnival is in Quebec City this year, and will be held in conjunction with other eastern ski councils. BRSC members interested in attending are encouraged to connect with the EPSC Melting Pot trip. Get all the details for this on page 7. Members may also look into participating with other clubs that offer reciprocal trip privileges.

Our extended eastern trip, which has been to Sunday River for the past few years, will move to Bolton Valley this year where we will be staying slopeside. Bolton Valley is in the heart of the central Vermont ski belt, an area known for its abundant snow, and has the highest base elevation of any Vermont ski area. Bolton is also known for its extensive cross-country and lift-served backcountry ski terrain, so if you lean towards self-powered skiing this trip is not to be missed!

Our western trip will be to Mt Bachelor in Bend, Oregon. Mt Bachelor is a "sleeping giant" of a ski resort, and with the fabulous town of Bend is rolling out a red carpet for the club. 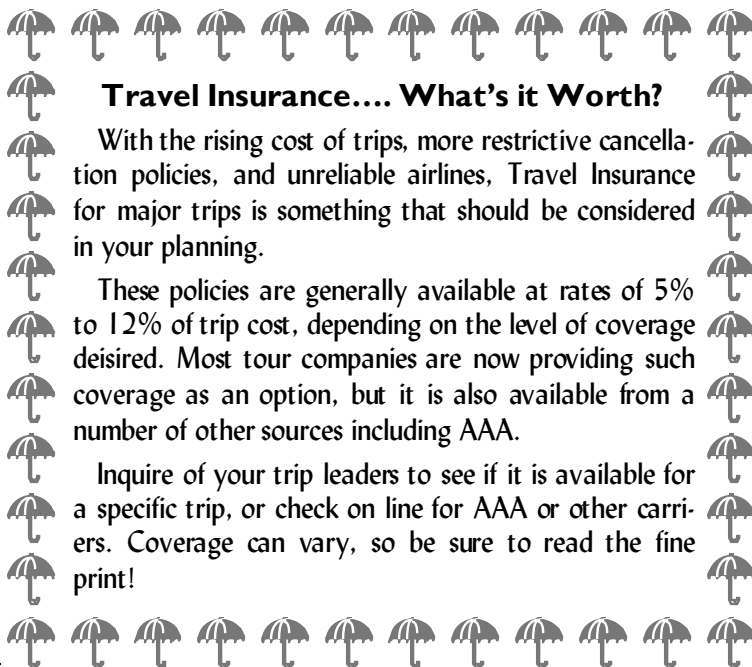

Travel Insurance... What's it Worth?

With the rising cost of trips, more restrictive cancellation policies, and unreliable airlines, Travel Insurance for major trips is something that should be considered in your planning.

These policies are generally available at rates of 5% to 12% of trip cost, depending on the level of coverage desired. Most tour companies are now providing such coverage as an option, but it is also available from a number of other sources including AAA.

Inquire of your trip leaders to see if it is available for a specific trip, or check on line for AAA or other carriers. Coverage can vary, so be sure to read the fine print!

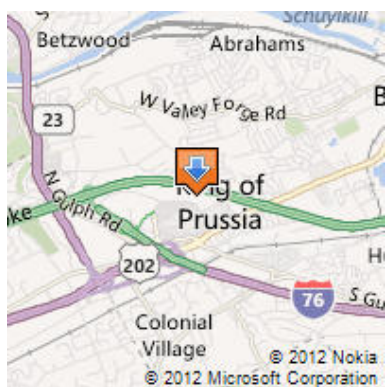
