

BRSC Woodbridge Lodge COVID procedures

The Woodbridge Lodge will continue to be available to club members. In recognition of the challenges in dealing with the COVID virus, the following procedures will be implemented:

- Bedrooms will be available for one related couple and their immediate minor children (18 or under) living in the same household.
- One bathroom will be assigned to each bedroom. Please use only the bathroom assigned to you.

Assuming no minor children, this means up to 6 people may use the facility at any one time. This should allow for social distancing in the living room and dining areas. Guests will need to work out a suitable cooking / kitchen use schedule, and are expected to wear masks when passing through the kitchen to the bathrooms.

Guests will be expected to sanitize eating and food prep surfaces at the *beginning* of their stay, both to address possible viral contamination from prior occupants AND clean up any resident mouse activity between use. Bathrooms are to be sanitized at the *end* of your stay, along with routine cleaning of eating and food prep surfaces. Disinfectant supplies that may be found beneath the vanities or the kitchen sink.

For the coming season, effective November 1 2020 the following rates will go into effect:

Season	Nov 1 – Apr 30	May 1 – Oct 31
Member rate	\$30.00	\$15.00
Family rate*	\$100.00	\$50.00
Guest rate	\$40.00	\$25.00

*Family rate applies to 2 adults and 2 or more children under age 18 living in the same household, and only applies to BRSC members (not guests). A family with only 1 child will pay at the regular member rate in effect.

If you are uncomfortable with others using the lodge, private use will be offered in return for a payment of double the lodging rate then in effect. For example, a member couple wishing exclusive use of the lodge would pay a total of \$60 per person per night in ski season, for a total of \$240 for a 2 night weekend. The lodge registrar must be informed of this at the time you reserve.

Buck Ridge Ski Club assumes no liability for ensuring the protocols outlined above will prevent anyone from contracting the virus. It is the obligation of all users to follow these guidelines to assist as much as possible in ensuring a safe stay. Although we endeavor to keep adequate cleaning supplies on hand it will help if all users bring a supply of sanitization products for personal as well as group use.
