

BUCK RIDGE SKI CLUB'S WOODBRIDGE LODGE AND YOU... PERFECT TOGETHER??



Buck Ridge Ski Club owns the Woodbridge Lodge, a rustic country lodge in southern Vermont just a few miles north of Mount Snow ski area. We are interested in partnering with smaller clubs within EPSC to help your ski club offer something more to members. We are not being completely benevolent – we want to improve the Lodge's bottom line! The Lodge has always operated independent of the Buck Ridge Ski Club finances to a large degree. With rising taxes and utilities, we are looking to increase usage and help our bottom line.

The Lodge has traditionally been available to Buck Ridge members and guests any time of the year. Recently, we moved to a “two tier” club membership, with club members being able to buy an annual “Lodge Privilege” that would give them preferred rates when staying at the Lodge. Basically, if you stay more than two nights at the Lodge you have paid for the lodge privilege cost. The money from the lodge privilege is used solely for operation of the lodge.

What we are proposing is to partner with your club to make the “Lodge Privilege” purchase available to your club members and help your club attract new members. **What the Lodge Privilege will give your club members is a relaxing place to stay, minutes from Stratton or Mount Snow and less than 30 miles to Bromley or Magic, at the preferred nightly rate of \$25 per person** in ski season. They would be able to make reservations at any time, or attend any of Buck Ridge's scheduled trips to the Lodge (there are usually four during the season), with the same rights as a Buck Ridge member. They would be allowed to bring up to three guests who would pay the guest rate of \$35 per night. During our trip planning in the summer, they would be able to request to host a trip.

And remember... **the Lodge is available year round.** Off-season rates for Lodge Privilege holders are only \$15 per night, and the three guest limit is waived. When it's 95 degrees and 95% humidity in Philadelphia, you will be lucky to see 80 degrees at the Lodge! Hiking, biking, or paddling... it's more better in Vermont!

What does the Lodge have to offer? Two fully equipped kitchens (all your need to bring is food), two dining areas, a large common room with gas fireplace, a ski room, two showers, and three bathrooms. There are three bunk-style bedrooms, two downstairs sleeping 6 each and one upstairs sleeping 8. There is NO television but there is a CD player and radio. There is no Wi-Fi but there is cell service.

Your members who may be interested in this benefit will receive an introductory package with details on how to get there, opening and closing the lodge (it's pretty easy), and how to make reservations. We hope you will make this offer available to your members!

Lodge Privilege entitles the holder access privilege to Buck Ridge Ski Club's Woodbridge Lodge at the preferred rate of \$25 per night in ski season (Nov. 1 to Apr. 30) and \$15 per night off-season. Privilege runs from September 30 of one year thru September 30 of the following, with any application received during the ski season effective the preceding September. Applications received after May 1 will automatically have privilege extended thru September of the following calendar year. All Lodge Privilege holders are required to maintain active membership in an Eastern Pennsylvania Ski Council (EPSC) member club. Failure to do so will be cause for termination of Lodge Privilege.

Family Membership is open to a family unit consisting of two adults and all children under 21 years of age living together a family unit. Children must be under 21 as of September 30; please list names and birth dates (with year) of all children. A family will pay a maximum of \$75 per night for all family members.

We hope you make full use of the Lodge and participate in annual work parties.
